VIVES ONG



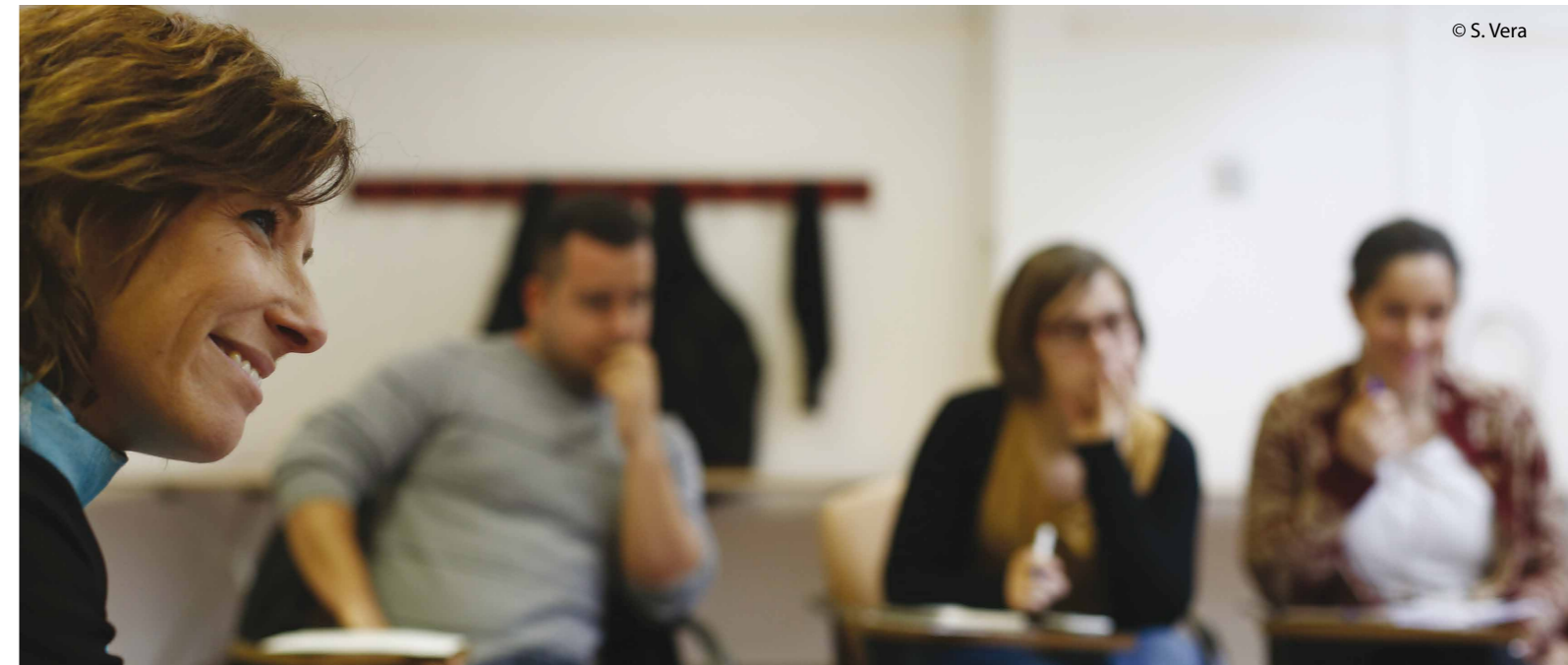
Aimed at organisations working in the field of social inclusion. We create partnerships with them to reach more people.

VIVES ECOSISTEMA

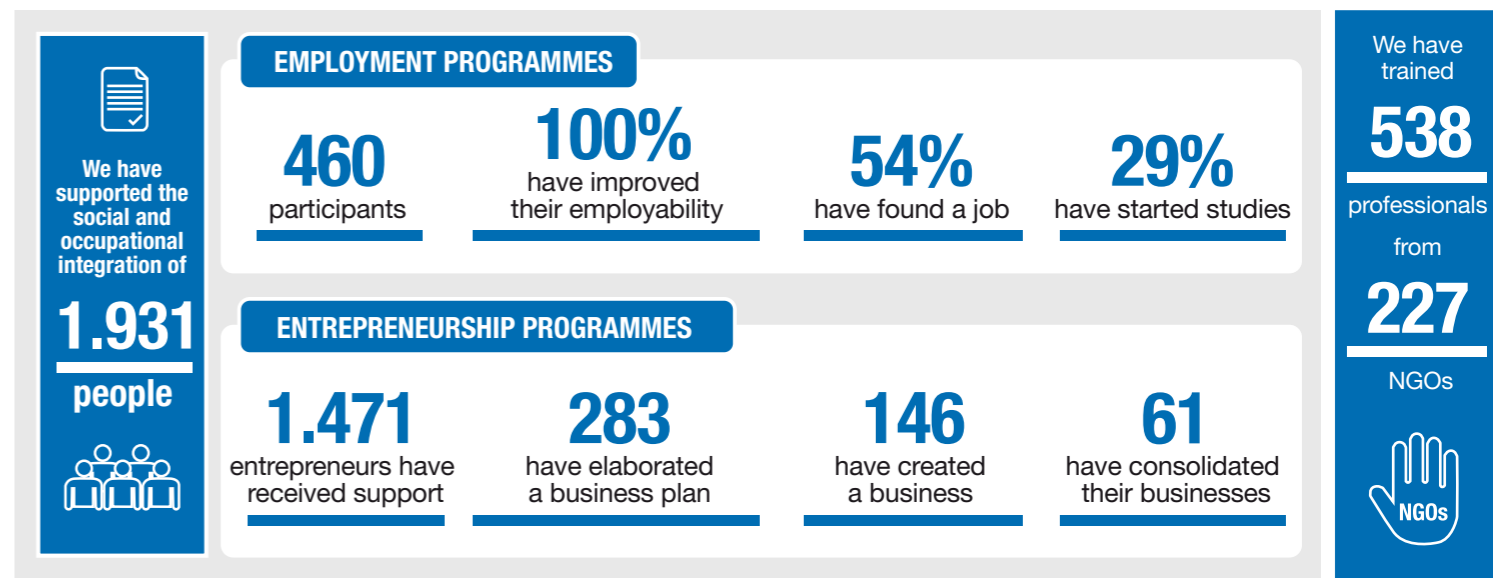


Aimed at the organisations, administrations, companies, etc., that are all part of the entrepreneurship ecosystem in Spain.

VIVES PERSONAS

We improve the employability of people at risk of social and labour exclusion in order to support their access to work or self-employment. In our work, we focus on personal development, teamwork, public-private alliances and social impact in the community.

• EMPLOYMENT INITIATIVES •

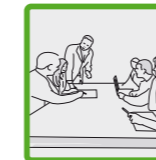
Vives Emplea

We improve people's employability through their participation in team itineraries for social and labour integration, helping them to access the job market or return to education.

• ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROJECTS •

Vives Emrende

We improve entrepreneurial skills and essential technical knowledge so that people who are at risk of exclusion can create or consolidate a business. We offer them training, advice, mentoring and access to funding.



VIVES ONG

We support other social organisations and public actors in their programmes to promote employment and entrepreneurship, aimed at people who are at risk of exclusion. This way, we indirectly achieve the social and occupational integration of more people.

• STRENGTHENING THE ENTREPRENEURSHIP SERVICES PROVIDED BY NGOs •

We work with organisations so they can establish or improve the assistance they provide to entrepreneurs. We provide training for NGO professionals, strategic consulting and internship and mentoring programmes to measure the impact on users.

• SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP •

We promote the start-up and consolidation of social entrepreneurship initiatives among non-profit organisations, with the aim of creating jobs within the groups with which they work, therefore generating more opportunities for social and occupational integration.



VIVES ECOSISTEMA

We work to make the entrepreneurship ecosystem inclusive. We collaborate by generating knowledge and participating in Spanish and European influence networks.

• KNOWLEDGE & RESEARCH •

We generate knowledge through research, discussion forums and meetings. We create tools that help with the entrepreneurship process (tutorials, manuals, etc.) and disseminate the Third Sector's work through the Flash Infosomal digital bulletin, social networks, websites, etc.

• NETWORKS •

We promote and participate in networks, contributing through our experience, resources and knowledge. We take part in:

European Networks for Inclusive Entrepreneurship

We foster the exchange of best practice and innovation to create a European employment and inclusive entrepreneurship ecosystem. The programmes in which we participate include Erasmus +, Horizon 2020 and the ESF in Romania (POSDRU).

Vives Proyecto was one of the organisations selected by Enterprise 2020, recognised as providing best practice in "Skills for Jobs".

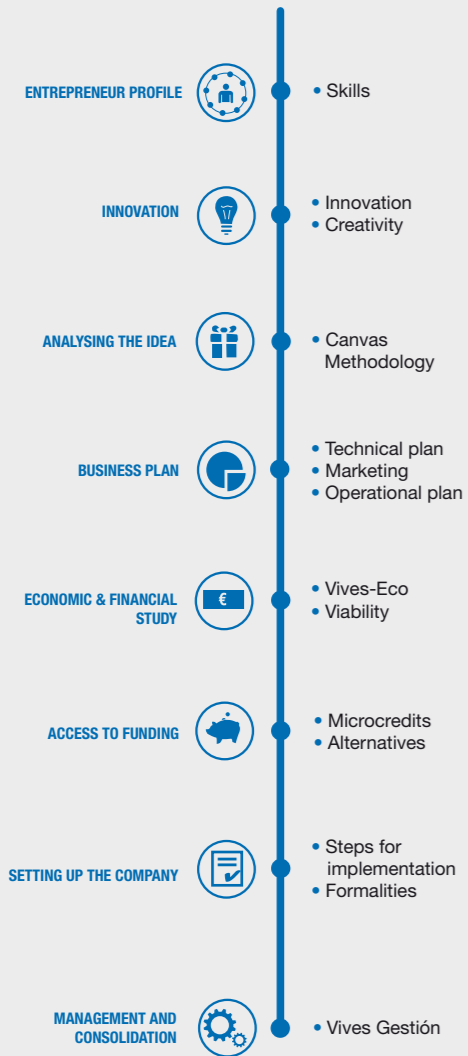

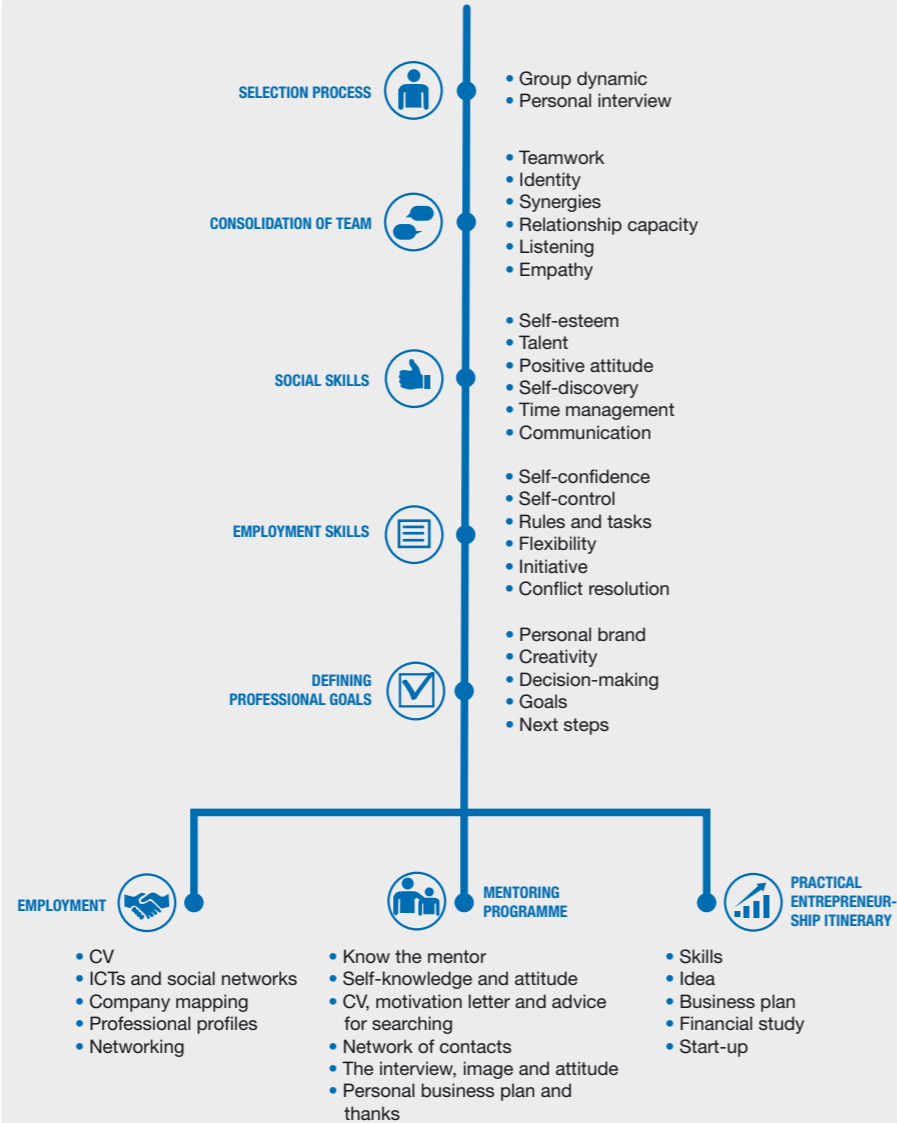
